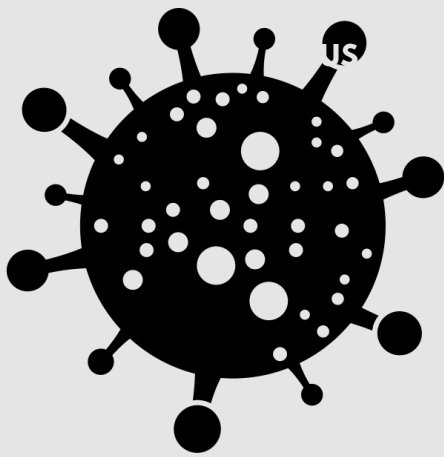
WEEK OF ACTION: 4/20-4/24
